The use of a roturner sit to stand transfer aid can remove the need for manual handling lowering the risk of injury to the caregiver, while providing a safer, more dignified and comfortable transfer solution for the client.

The sturdy frame instills confidence in the client as they make the transition between a bed, seat, commode or wheelchair. The wide turntable provides a stable and safe area that the client can step onto while the transfer takes place.

It rotates between five different positions with a locking device to ensure client safety.

### Robust, strong and built to last!

The roturner is manufactured in St. Catharines, Ontario by Niagara Precision Limited for Jaide Products Inc.















Before moving the roturner be sure it is in the locked position. The assistant then wheels the roturner into position in front of the seated client.

Press the black foot bar down and gently glide the roturner closer to the client and under their feet.



The client places their feet on the turntable and hands onto the handle grip area and is assisted from the seated position to a standing position.



Lifting the brake handle the assistant then unlocks and rotates the turntable left or right.

The assistant then releases the brake into one of 5 locking positions.



The assistant may now transfer the client to a previously placed wheelchair or other seat, then remove the roturner.
